Counter Terrorism attack policy and procedure

Magdalene preschool is committed to protecting all the children in our care from harm. We follow all guidelines and requirements from Government and Local Authority and take positive and proactive steps to safeguard children, families, staff and visitors.

Magdalene preschool has sought advice from National Counter Terrorism Policing Team and were visited by our Safer Neighbourhood Team. The public guidance advice we will follow in the rare event of a firearms or weapons attack which sets out the key options for keeping safe is as follows:

Never open the outside door to unidentified visitors.

Gather the children together in a barricaded room until police arrive.

The safest options chosen by the police team is the 'Quiet room' with barricades at each end and windows. The kitchen with doors bolted and hatch closed.

We will follow the advice '**Run**', '**Hide**' '**Tell**'.

'Run' – to a place of safety. This is a better option than to surrender or negotiate. If there is nowhere to go then . . .

'Hide' – Remember to turn phones to silent and turn off vibrate. Barricade yourself in if you can.

'Tell' – the police by calling **999** when it is safe to do so.
